

underwater archaeology field school San Vito Lo Capo (Sicily)

Underwater Archaeology Field Schools are organized and conducted by Giano s.n.c., together with Sea Diver s.r.l. and with Glaucos a.s.d., in collaboration with the Soprintendenza del Mare (Sea Heritage Supervision Office) of Sicily.

The courses are part of the San Vito lo Capo Underwater Project, which is currently working on mapping the distribution of archaeological material deposited on San Vito bay's seabed, where sites and shipwrecks are plentiful, dating to Roman, late antique, and medieval periods. The school will provide the W.A.S.E. ARCHAEOLOGY DIVER license along with a certificate of attendance issued by the Soprintendenza del Mare.

This course is designed for students and graduates in archaeology, architecture, marine biology, geology, and for professionals or amateurs willing to increase their working experience and knowledge of underwater archaeology.

The students will learn how to deal with an underwater archaeological site study, the project's surveying and mapping activities, as well as executing the related graphical-photographic production and the classification of the finds.

The participants will get the chance of becoming acquainted with the professional tools and the experimental methods of research and documentation in underwater archaeology.

The underwater sessions will be integrated by operative tests on land and specific lectures on technical topics, ranging from classes of materials and assemblages to the management and conservation of underwater archaeological sites.

INFORMATION AND CONTACT

This year there will be two field schools, the first one occurring in June/July and the second one in September. The number of attending students for each session is limited to 15 persons.

Participation fee includes the accommodation, the W.A.S.E. Archaeology Diver license, a full DAN diving insurance, all of the course related materials, complete supply of air tanks and weight belts to be employed during the dives.
